Points of Interest:

POI Rolle: (GPS 28) Beautiful promenade in Rolle

POI Prex: (GPS 46) Interesting medieval village with lovely port.

We follow the lake the whole way to Morges except for a few moments when you'll veer off to the west towards the Jura mountains.

The morning we'll be going down "La Route Suisse". This is a busy road, but there is a dedicated bike path on the right and it will allow you to go fast and stretch your legs. At 16.5 kilometers (GPS 3), there is a sign for the village of *Celigny* and we will need to turn left. At this point the countryside becomes more interesting. We'll reach *Celigny* after a kilometer or two. This is a good place for our first coffee/bathroom break.

We stop on *Rolle's* lakeside promenade for lunch. If you're not with the group, look for the fountain on the main street. Across from the fountain, you will see an arched path leading through to the lake. If you follow the lake (away from the chateau) you will find Johno with the van.

St. Prex is an easy-to-miss village on your itinerary just before Morges. We will plan to stop for a stroll.

Morges is a delightful and flower-decked town of 14,000 inhabitants. It occupies a privileged position on the shores of Lake Geneva, opposite the majestic Mont-Blanc. This evening we'll be eating at "The Casino". This is an elegant restaurant on the lake that was once a "*fin de Siécle*" casino.

Notes: Always refer to your cell phone for messages concerning evening activities. We normally meet for supper at 7 PM unless otherwise indicated. We will also try to leave each morning by 9 AM, which means having our gear downstairs and our bikes out by 8:45.
