

Return to Geneva via Berne

Berne's a great city. It's my favorite Swiss city and we suggest you stop there. But of course, you're welcome to go straight back to Geneva.

We recommend getting a picnic together and then crossing through town to the Rose Garden (above the bear pits). It's a bit of a walk/climb (30 minutes), but the view of the city is well worth it.

There is also a restaurant/terrace at the Rose Garden that is relatively inexpensive considering the location. Otherwise, if weather is bad, Restaurant "Anker" on Kornhausplatz is a great place for a Roesti (Swiss specialty) and beer.

If it's Saturday, stores in Berne close very early...around 4:30 p.m.. If it's Sunday, only you'll only find the museums and a few restaurants open.

The following train schedule can be used for your return applied to all hours of the day:

Depart Romanshorn at 8:40 from platform 3

Arrive in Zurich at 9:51 on track 31 (downstairs)

Go upstairs to platform 15

Depart Zurich at 10:03 on Platform 15

Arrive in Geneva at 12:45 (unless you decide to stop in Berne)
